HCO- VIOLIN PROGRAM

Beginner, from 6 years old

2-year Training Programme

1st semester	Basics
2nd semester	3/4 of book 1
3rd semester	Half way mark of book 2
4th semester	Complete book 2
3rd year	Join HCO-Training Orchestra for 2 years

Criteria:

- i. Student is required to take an internal exam at the end of every semester;
- ii. Student must pass the exam each semester, otherwise he/she will be placed on probation and retake the exam in 1 month time;
- iii. If student still does not pass the exam, he/she will need to leave the programme.
- iv. Minimum attendance: Student must maintain at least 80% attendance throughout the program; Exceptions: Special circumstances (eg. PSLE preparation leave) may be considered on a case-by-case basis. Such cases must be discussed and approved in advance.

Opportunities & benefits:

- a) To play at student concerts
- b) Possibility of performing with the HCO and/or at HOS Concerts

Violin Program Trial First 3 months (Individual)	Actual Fee: \$45 (30min) \$67.50 (45min) \$90 (60min)	3 lessons in a month; By end of 3 months, teacher and parents/student will assess suitability to carry on with violin program.
